A WORD FROM OUR PRESIDENT

Dear Friends of HFOT,

This year, Homes For Our Troops strengthened our mission in powerful and meaningful ways. We proudly handed over the keys of 23 specially adapted custom homes to deserving Veterans and their families, welcomed two dozen new Veterans into the HFOT family, and reached the milestone of kicking off our first home in Wyoming—our 46th state nationwide.

Amid a year of unprecedented demands in construction—and with building costs rising more than 70 percent over the past five years—we ended the fiscal year with \$46M in revenue, supported by more than 45,000 donations from individual donors, corporate partners, foundations, and fundraisers. None of this progress would be possible without the generosity of our steadfast supporters. Because of you, we are able to sustain our commitment to serving Veterans and their families.

This Annual Impact Report highlights the tangible difference your support makes for severely injured post-9/11 Veterans and their families. In addition to financial results, you will hear directly from this year's home recipients as they share how receiving a specially adapted custom home has transformed their lives.

As we reflect on the progress made this year, our focus is firmly on the work that lies ahead. Based on VA estimates, we assess that nearly 1,800 post-9/11 Veterans are still awaiting the stability and independence that a specially adapted custom HFOT home provides—underscoring the urgency of our mission. With your continued commitment, we enter the new year prepared to further our efforts to Build Homes and Rebuild Lives.

Together, we can help restore the freedom and independence our Veterans sacrificed in service to our nation. On behalf of HFOT's staff and Board of Directors, thank you for an exceptional year. We look forward to all we will accomplish together in 2026.




